Important Notice

Bolesworth will be operating a vaccination policy which follows FEI guidance, not British Showjumping.

All horses including National entries, must be vaccinated every six months. Please see policy below.

Breed Papers must be lodged with British Showjumping at the time of registration or your entry will not be accepted.

You must confirm at time of entry if you wish your horse to be eligible for selection for the FEI World Breeding Championships – Zangersheide by selecting the box

You must confirm by selecting the box if your horse is:

- A) British bred.
- B) Non- British Bred (includes British bred with non-British based passport);

If you do not select this at entry, you are not eligible for selection.

Breeding definitions:

British Bred - A horse that holds a British based breed studbook

Non-British Bred - Includes British Breeds without British based studbooks

ENTRIES	For all International entries, including amateur, please visit bolesworthyounghorse.com and download the international schedule. Entries must be made via the FEI online entries system and via your national federation.
INTERNATIONAL STABLES	International horses must be stabled on site for the duration of the show and may not leave at any time.
DECLARATIONS	Close at 19:00 each evening for the following day's classes. Drawn orders will be published by 20:00 on bolesworthyounghorse.com

British Breeders

Prizes for the Breeders of the Top 5 British Bred Horses in their respective Finals

Prizes: £850, £450, £300, £200, £200

These Prizes have been kindly sponsored by the British Showjumping and will be distributed following the Championships by British Showjumping Head Office.

Any discrepancy in the allocation of this prize money will be referred to the British Show Jumping Performance Committee

Rules for Qualification for the Finals of the 5, 6 and 7 yr. old Championships

1. Horse/Rider Combinations will be awarded points on their placing in each of the two preliminary rounds (they must start in both rounds). The total of these points will produce a League Table, from which the top 50 (minimum) will qualify for the Finals.

2. Any combination jumping clear in both the preliminary rounds will be guaranteed a place in the Final. In the event of equality for the final qualifying place in the league table, the combination with the highest place from the second preliminary round will qualify.

3. For every 10 entries above 50, 1 extra qualifying place will be allotted to each final.

4. Any horse which is eliminated due to two refusals in any preliminary rounds will not be eligible to compete in the finals.

Points will be awarded as follows:

1st = 1 point, 2nd = 2 points, 3rd = 3 points, 4th = 4 points, 5th = 5 points, 6th = 6 points, 7th = 7 points etc. until all those that have competed in the class are awarded points.

The horse with the least points will be ranked number 1. As competitors will be placed equal then the points awarded will be added and divided by the number of horses equally placed (i.e. If ten horses are equal 1st then we add 1+2+3+4+5+6+7+8+9+10 = 55 then divide by the ten equals giving each horse a total of 5.5 points).

Prize Giving

All Competitions – Those required for awards ceremony must attend.

Breeders - Breeders of the top 3 British Bred Horses in their respective Finals will be invited

into the ring to be presented with their awards.

Owners & Grooms – The Owner and Groom of the winning horse in each Final will be invited into the ring to be presented with their awards.

Equitop Bolesworth Young Horse Championships 2019

FEI World Breeding Championships – Zangersheide.

The Bolesworth Young Horse Championships is the qualifying show for the World Breeding Championship for Young Horses, in Lanaken (BEL). The top four British Bred horses, holding British based breed passports, in the 5 and 6-year-old finals, will qualify. The top three British Bred horses, holding a British based breed passport, will also qualify in the 7-Year-Old Final, **provided that they have ticked the relevant box on the Entry Form**. 'Wildcard' will be awarded to the top 4 four non- British Bred 5 and 6 year olds and the top 3 non-British bred 7 Year Olds in their respective Finals (these would also include British Breds without British based passports), **providing that they have ticked the relevant box on the Entry Form**, and these will be forwarded to Zangersheide for their consideration (please see the Zangersheide rules below).

FEI World Breeding Championships for Young Horses – Zangersheide Rules
British Bred Horses

Great Britain is allocated a certain number of places to enter horses from a studbook which is domiciled in GB.

Foreign Bred Horses

Will only be accepted via an application for a Wildcard

- a. The Organising Committee will only accept entries for wildcards made by the concerning National Federations invited by the Organising Committee.
- b. Horses that wish to be eligible to receive a wildcard must be registered at a studbook which is member of the WBFSH.
- c. Wildcards can be provided to horses which for instance qualified themselves but have not been selected as their native country is not the same as their country of residence. The Organising Committee, in accordance with the FEI, has the right to adjust the number of quotas in case too many qualified horses apply for a wildcard. This might be the case when in the country they have qualified themselves, the National Federation does not want to take them in their quota. This is to keep the number of horses from one breeding area in proportion.
- d. National Federations who have been given a quota cannot apply for wildcards for horses that are registered in the national studbooks of the nation of that National Federation.
- e. All applications for wildcards must be motivated by the National Federations and should be accompanied with show results. These results must be faxed or sent by email to the organizer.
- f. The Organising Committee will not provide wildcards to horses that have participated at young horse's competitions without success.
- g. After the closing date for the definite entries all National Federations will be advised about the provided wildcards.

- h. The Organising Committee, in consultation with the FEI, will decide upon wildcards; no further appeal is possible.
- i. Wildcards are only provided to specific selected horses. Once these horses are selected, they cannot be substituted by a National Federation. Only the Organising Committee can allow substitutions.
- j. Only horses selected by the Team Manager will be able to apply for a Wildcard

2019 Format: The Eventing Grand Prix will consist of up to 20 individual riders. Each rider will compete a course of Show Jumps and Cross-Country obstacles in the main arena, against the clock. The order of competitors will be drawn. The order will be drawn in the Hospitality Marquee at a briefing, that all riders are expected to attend at 5pm.

Course: Show Jumps will be a maximum of 1.25m, and 3 seconds will be added for each fence knocked down. There will be an optional joker at a maximum height of 1.35m (eraser rule minus 3sec if clear plus 3 if knocked down). Cross country obstacles will be built to maximum height and difficulty of Intermediate level. 3 cumulative refusals will result in elimination.

1) The Organiser referred to in these Rules and Conditions shall hereinafter mean Bolesworth Events LLP, Bolesworth International will hereinafter be referred to as The Show.

2) So far as permitted by law the Organiser, its officers, employees and representatives will not be liable to any person whatsoever whilst upon, entering, or leaving the Showground for any loss,

damage, death injury or accident to persons or property or for lost or stolen items.

3) Each Exhibitor must keep the Organiser its officers, employees and representatives fully indemnified against all losses, actions, costs, claims, demands and expenses arising directly or indirectly out of any act, omission or negligence by him or by any one attending the Show, in connection with his entry or otherwise expressly or impliedly with his authority. Therefore, all Exhibitors, Competitors and Owners are strongly advised to take out third-party liability insurance. The Organiser cannot advise on policies or their suitability and it is the individual's responsibility to obtain advice wherever necessary. Exhibitors, Owners and Competitors are personally responsible for ensuring that they take all necessary measures with regard to health and safety. The attention of exhibitors with stallions is drawn to BS Rule 82.21. No member of the BS/BD shall allow a stallion for which he is responsible, as owner, lessee, authorised agent, or rider to attend a show, compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other horses/ponies, competitors and members of the public are not put at risk of injury.

4) The Organisers reserve the right to cancel, add to, or amend any of the Classes in accordance with British Showjumping.

5) Signature by the person making the entries shall be deemed to be an acceptance of the Conditions herein contained.

6) JUMPING COMPETITIONS.

This event is organised in accordance with the rules of the British Show Jumping Association, British Dressage and the FEI.

7) DECLARATIONS

Declarations are required for all classes in all arenas. They should be made not later than 1900 hrs the day before the class.

8) SUBSTITUTIONS

Are in accordance with BS Rules.

9) ORDER OF JUMPING.

The order of jumping for classes in all arenas each day, will be drawn. Horses must jump in the order they appear on the Running Order, which will be posted, unless special permission has been obtained from the Judges.

10) STANDARD.

When a standard set by the Judges has been reached, any competitor making more than the fixed number of penalties shall be retired.

11) OBJECTIONS.

Objections should be made in writing in accordance with BS Rule 198. A £100 deposit in cash will be required per objection.

12) VACCINATION AGAINST EQUINE INFLUENZA

All horses at the Show must have a current and valid certificate of vaccination against Equine Influenza. There will be random checking of certificates and any horse or pony found without a valid certificate will not be permitted to remain on the showground.

All competitors (National and International) must have up to date vaccinations (within 6 months) as per FEI regulations.

13) STABLING.

Stables may be booked for the duration of the Show at a price of £125.00. Stables must be booked on the entry form. Competitors wishing to check that their stable reservation has been confirmed should contact the Entries Secretary.

14) BEDDING & FORAGE.

Shavings £10.50, fodder, haylage £10 and hay can be purchased on site from Stable Manager.

15) ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE AT SHOW.

The stable area will be open from 14:00 on Tuesday 13th August 2019. Competitors may not arrive between the hours of 2200 hrs and 0600 hrs without prior arrangement with the Show.

16) PRIZE MONEY.

Prize money will be paid via bank transfer immediately after the show or by cheque from the secretary.

In the event of insufficient starters rule **76.6.1** may be applied.

17) The Organisers reserve the right to invite riders to compete in championship classes.

18) ENTRIES.

(a) CLOSING DATE:

Entries close on 26th of July 2019 or before if maximums are reached.

(b) The Show may at its absolute discretion, decline any entry, or exclude or remove any person or animal from the show or future shows or return any entry fee without being required to assign any reason or being liable for any compensation.

(c) In the event that a cheque has to be re-presented to the bank, each time a £15 charge will be added to the riders account.

(d) Entry fees that are not received in full by 1st of September 2019 may be subject to a 100% surcharge.

19) REFUND OF ENTRY FEES.

Refunds will only be made in accordance with BS Rule 79.5 and not at all after 12 noon on Monday the 12th August 2019. Stabling fees will not be refunded.

20) MEDICAL CHARGE.

Exhibitors are required to contribute £15 towards medical cover.

21) FARRIER & VETERINARY SURGEON.

The services of a vet & farrier are available at the show. Owners and/or the person responsible are responsible for any costs incurred.

22) MOTOR BIKES, SCOOTERS & BICYCLES Motorbikes & bicycles WILL NOT BE PERMITTED anywhere on the showground.

23) ESTATE.

Under no circumstances may any horse go on to any other areas of the estate, other than that area designated for the event. Any horse found outside of the designated area will be eliminated from the show.

24) TROPHIES.

Trophies are all perpetual & the winner is responsible for their safe return and insurance when in their possession. Trophies should be collected from the Show Office.

25) Electric Hook Up

A limited number of electric hook ups are available. The power source is via a generator. The event will endeavour to provide continuous supply but cannot guarantee this.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL EXHIBITORS

- 1) Access to the showground on Tuesday 13th August 2019 will not be before 14:00. Competitors may not arrive between 2200 hrs and 0600 hrs without prior agreement with the show.
- 2) A 5mph speed limit will be strictly enforced within the showground.
- 3) Open fires will not be allowed under any circumstance. Purpose built Barbeques will be allowed under strict supervision.
- 4) Horses must not be left tethered or unattended whilst out of the stable or transporters under any circumstances.
- 5) Dogs off leads are strictly forbidden on the show ground.
- 6) The main fire point is located at the stable manager's office.
- 7) All horses must remain within the designated areas and walkways at all times. It is strictly forbidden to exercise or move horses in any areas other than those designated as walkways, warm up areas or stabling area.
- 8) The stabling area is designated as a no smoking area.

FIRE PROCEDURE

In the event of a fire:

- 1) Raise the alarm.
- 2) The Stable Manager will ensure that the Fire Brigade are notified.
- 3) Public address announcements will give clear evacuation announcements.
- 4) Stewards will assist the security and event managers in crowd control.
- 5) The show director will co-ordinate and evaluate the situation.
- 6) The show director will liaise with the Fire Brigade on their arrival.
- 7) Follow instructions from the Senior Fire Officer present.

Declarations must be made for all classes in all arenas by 1900 hrs on the day before the class. Drawn orders can be viewed online at www.bolesworthyounghorse.com or the secretary's office. Drawn orders will not be available before 8pm the day before the class.

Location and getting to Bolesworth International

Bolesworth Castle, Tattenhall, Chester CH3 9HQ

Bolesworth Castle and the Estate are conveniently situated just 15 minutes south of Chester on the main A41. The show will be clearly signposted from the A41.

From East via M56 – M53

Take the M53 South towards Chester. M53 becomes the A55. Leave the A55 at Junction 40 (previously Junction 37). At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto A51. At the traffic lights, turn right onto A41 signposted Whitchurch. Follow the A41 through Christleton, Waverton and Hatton Heath for approx 7.5 miles. Follow the signs for the appropriate entrance to the Bolesworth International.

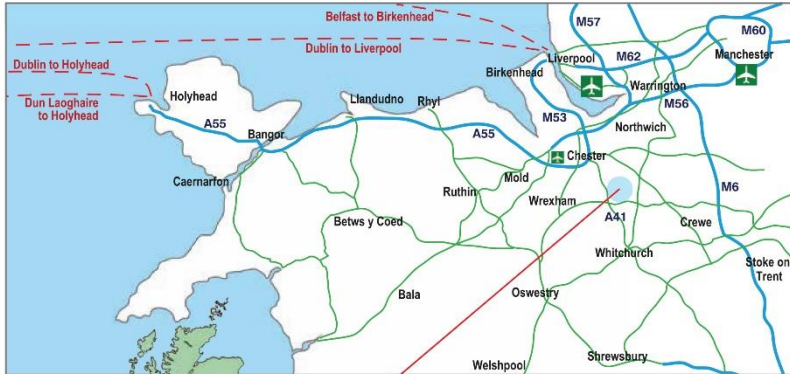
From Holyhead – North Wales via A55

From the North Wales direction, take the A55 towards Chester – branching left at Junction 37 onto the A55 signposted for Chester. Follow the A55 towards Chester and take Junction 39 (was Junction 36a) towards Whitchurch.

Take the right hand lane at the traffic lights and turn right onto the A41 signposted Whitchurch. Follow the A41 through Christleton, Waverton and Hatton Heath for approx. 7.5 miles. Follow the signs for the appropriate entrance to the Bolesworth International.

From the South via M6

From the Birmingham direction, take the M6 North. Leave the M6 at Junction 16 signposted Crewe/Nantwich. At the roundabout take 1st exit onto A500 Nantwich. Follow the A500 to Nantwich. At Cheerbrook roundabout take the 3rd exit onto the A51 signposted for Chester. At the Burford Crossroads continue forward onto A534 Wrexham Road. At crossroads turn right onto A534.
